













When compared to the previous year (2023), during 2024, your total turnover?
Aggregate amount








What are the main reasons that you feel led to the decrease in sales (turnover) in 2024?




When compared to the previous year, how profitable was your business?

What are the main causes of price increases in your business (if any)?


















The 2 most important issues the country is facing and you would like the government to do something about Select only Two






In your opinion, Malta is moving in the right direction or in the wrong direction?

"Excessive reliance on compliance increases costs"

"Accessibility to banking and bank charges"

Observations & Recommendations.

Observations.

Delayed payments from clients or institutions are negatively affecting cash flow for businesses, particularly SMEs.

 Salary Cost, Wage Costs and Costs of Products coming from abroad are the main causes of price increase.

 Overpopulation, coupled with a lack of infrastructure to accommodate growth, are impinging on the quality of life for citizens.

Observations.

2024 compared very similarly in terms of profitability, with 2023, with the majority recording that profits remained the same.

 Employee shortages and difficulty sourcing talent locally are causing disruptions, especially in industries heavily reliant on skilled labour.

 This perception of unfairness and inequality is undermining trust in the system.

Observations.

The real cost of doing business in Malta is also increasing, with many respondents recording reasons of local nature as the main reason for price increase within their business.

 Government needs to ensure that any decisions' taken at political level do not lead to further inflations.

Recommendations.

 Government needs to seriously address issues of unfair competition.

 Strengthen transparency and anti-corruption measures to rebuild trust in public institutions.

 Policies tied with labour migration need to reflect the country's economic vision.
